





In a moment, you can buy the needed gift card right on your cell phone and use the balance immediately to pay for your purchase.

You can acquire the **Raise Right (by Shop With Scrip) Mobile App** on your Apple/iOS or Android/Google smart phone by going to the App Store. Sign up by using SPI's enrollment code, which is 132EA2LD6L3. (If you are asked for your SPI representative's name, it is Karey Fuelling.) You will carry a balance for virtual cards on your phone. It is so handy to just pay at the store's register using your cell phone.
